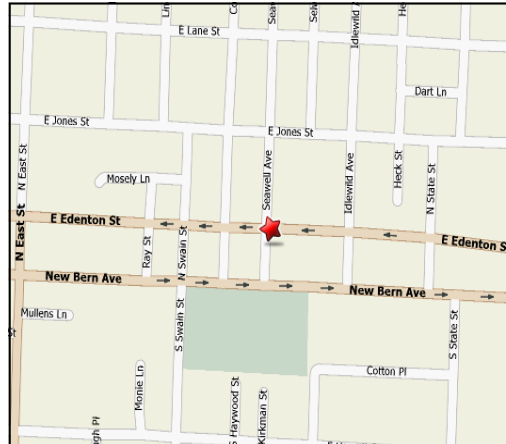

lives of the children and families of Wake County. HMHB was founded in 1990 as a response to the high infant mortality rates in Wake County.

Today, we continue in our mission to reduce infant mortality rate, and have actively expanded our efforts to include working to prevent teen pregnancy and juvenile delinquency, collaborating with health and education systems and offering community support through various free services.

Services

HMHB serves the community by:

- Donating food, clothing and baby supplies
- Hosting free HIV/AIDS testing weekly
- Providing individuals with information about helpful resources



Community Initiatives

HMHB has four programs to promote healthy habits and lifestyles, the importance of education and making wise decisions:

Healthy Families Initiative offers community-based educational and support groups to women in low income communities.

Lighthouse provides support to youth ages 12-17 who are at risk for school failure and drop out and involvement with the juvenile justice system.

Sin Fronteras is an adolescent pregnancy prevention and life skills curriculum project for male and female Latino youth ages 10-15.

Sisters in Motion assists teen moms up to age 17 establish and achieve short and long term goals.
